## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Heart in Diabetes (HiD) brings a multi-specialty world-renowned leaders in diabetes, obesity and cardiorenal metabolic diseases interpreting state of the art clinical data to improve the care of the complex patients with these comorbidities.

This year, the conference will focus on incorporating emerging data including clinical trials outcome into clinical practice. Emphasis will be given on implementing guidelines directed to medical treatment, addressing when and how to intervene early to prevent and manage morbidities in patients with Diabetes, Cardiorenal and Metabolic diseases. The program will mix didactic presentations with cross-specialty panels with leading experts in cardiology, nephrology, endocrinology, and primary care experts. The interactive discussions allows ample time for Q & A, addressing treatment modalities and implications to practice providing tools to ultimately improve the outcome of these patients.
